Ms. Yuyum Fhahni Paryani is currently an Independent Emergency Specialist and Consultant for Child Protection and an External Member of the Emergency Roster of Plan International.

Ms. Paryani previously worked as an Emergency Specialist and Consultant on Child Protection for Plan International Nepal in 2015. With her specific assignment on Earthquake Disaster, she spearheaded the conduct of capacity building trainings and job mentoring for the communities, staff and mobilizers of Plan International in the Shindupalcwok and Dolakha Districts in Nepal. She was also part of the Emergency Response Team during Typhoon Haiyan in Bay Bay, Leyte, Philippines in 2013, and during Typhoon Ruby in Western and Eastern Samar, Philippines, in 2015.

Ms. Paryani has worked for almost 6 years in Plan International Indonesia as a Community-Based Child Protection (CBCP) Specialist as well as a member of the Emergency Response Team (ERT) as a Child Protection Specialist.
