Nationally, as a Chief Gender Equality Officer, the Ministry of Social Development and Human Security, she has formulated the Working Plan on Gender Equality Promotion for Chief Gender Equality Officers in all line ministries and departments. She is a dynamic gender equality advocate with a successful track record in advising and leading negotiations. both nationally, regionally, and internationally on general equality measures, elimination of discrimination, and women's advancement. Her dynamic participation in the women's rights agenda has led her to be appointed as the Chair of the ASEAN Commission on the Promotion and Protection of the Rights of Women and Children (ACWC) as well as the Thailand's Representative for Women's Rights to the ACWC since 2010. She is recipient of the Knight Grand Cordon (Special Class) of the Most Noble Order of the Crown of Thailand (2008).
